

Information on Registration Renewal Process for English Preparatory Class Students

- 1- Preparation Class students should follow the website ydyo.iyte.edu.tr for Fall Semester registration renewal procedures. Students who are repeating the English Preparatory Class or international students will need to make a fee payment.

Information on Courses Available for First-Year Students

- 1- The course load for first-year students consists of the first-year courses listed in the curriculum. First-year students cannot take courses from higher years (including Turkish and History courses) (Undergraduate Regulation Article 8/2).
- 2- There must be no overlap in the courses you select (Undergraduate Regulation Article 8/5).

Information on Course Selection for Second, Third, and Fourth-Year Students

- 1- Students with a cumulative GPA below 1.80 and on repeat status cannot take new courses. They can only retake courses they have previously taken (either to improve grades or to pass).
- 2- Students with a cumulative GPA above 1.80 at the end of the second semester can take a number of courses equal to the credit hours in their current semester's curriculum, provided it does not exceed their course load. If approved by the advisor, they may take courses from higher years as long as it does not exceed their course load.
- 3- With advisor approval, students with a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher may take an additional 2 courses, and students with a GPA of 2.50 or higher may take an additional 3 courses beyond their standard course load.

Note: With advisor approval, students in the 7th and 8th semesters with a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher can take an additional 3 courses beyond their standard course load.
