

2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR FALL SEMESTER**Announcement Regarding Registration Renewal for Basic English Preparatory Class and Undergraduate Students.****Important**

Students are responsible for conducting their course registration procedures in accordance with the regulations currently in force, specifically the IZTECH Student Registration and Admission Regulations, the IZTECH Undergraduate Education and Training Regulations, and the IZTECH Operating Procedures for Undergraduate Students. Students themselves shall bear sole responsibility for any To renew the registration; If any, the tuition fee or tuition fee must be paid, the course selection process must be made and the advisor's approval must be obtained. Students are responsible for the entire registration renewal process. A student who misses one of these transactions is considered unregistered.

Since your contribution payments will be transferred from the bank to ÖBS electronically, receipts will not be delivered to the Registrar's Office.

Students who cannot graduate within the normal education period pay a contribution.

English Preparatory Class students will not perform any course selection. They are required to follow the announcements on the website ydyo.iztech.edu.tr for registration renewal procedures.

Advisor Approval and Course Add-Removal procedures will be carried out together with the advisor.

Students who fail to graduate within the standard period of study (8 semesters) are required to pay a tuition fee.

International students (excluding scholarship recipients) are required to pay a tuition fee.

Regardless of whether they exceed the normal education period or not, students who enroll in a second higher education program (excluding double major programs) while enrolled in a higher education program pay a contribution.

Your military service transactions are transmitted to the Ministry of National Defense from YÖKSİS via web services by our Institute. As of August 27, 2018, the Registrar's Office has not followed up on military service. You can follow up your military procedures via e-government and/or military branches and report any problems to the Registrar's Office.

Information Regarding Course Selection for First-Year Students.
The course load for first-year students comprises only the first-year courses specified in the academic curriculum. First-year students are not permitted to enroll in upper-year courses, including Turkish and History courses. (Undergraduate Regulations, Article 8/2)
There must be no schedule conflicts among the courses you have selected. (Undergraduate Regulations, Article 8/5)
Information Regarding Course Selection for Second-, Third-, and Fourth-Year Students.
Students whose cumulative grade point average is below 1.80 and who are required to repeat cannot enroll in new courses. They may only retake previously completed courses (either failed courses or f
Students whose cumulative grade point average is above 1.80 as of the end of their second semester may enroll in as many credit-bearing courses specified in their curriculum for that semester, provided they do not exceed the maximum course load. If deemed appropriate by their academic advisor, they may also enroll in upper-level courses, again without exceeding the maximum course load.
With the advisor's approval, a student whose cumulative grade point average is at least 2.00 may enroll in up to two additional courses beyond the standard course load, whereas a student whose cumul
With the advisor's approval, seventh- and eighth-semester students whose cumulative grade point average is at least 2.00 may take up to three additional courses beyond the standard course load.

Information Regarding Courses for Which the Attendance Requirement Does Not Apply to Repeating Students.			
In Article 8, Paragraph (5) of the İZTECH Undergraduate Education and Training Regulations, it is stated: “(5) There must be no overlap among the courses selected by the student. However, in the case of repeating courses that were previously failed despite fulfilling the attendance requirement, as determined by the Senate, this restriction does not apply.” Likewise, Article 9, Paragraph (2) stipulates: “(2) In the case of repeating courses that were previously failed despite fulfilling the attendance requirement (excluding courses with an NA or W grade), there is no attendance requirement for the courses determined by the Senate.” Courses included within the Senate's scope and offered in the current semester may be added through the Student Information System by the students' academic advisors during the “Advisor Course Add/Drop Approval” period (from Thursday, October 8, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. to Friday, October 9, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.). Students who wish to enroll in these course(s) should contact their academic advisors.
